

Wait for the download to complete. Then click on **WindowsPCHealthCheckSetup.msi** to install the app.



Review the license agreement, and then click I accept. Once accepted, click Install.



Once the Windows PC Health Check setup is complete, click **Finish** to launch the app.





PC Health check app results


a) Hold Message

RUN THE PC HEALTH CHECK APP

Windows 11 is the latest version of Microsoft Windows. The minimum hardware and software requirements must be met before upgrading to Windows 11. Microsoft has released the minimum hardware requirements:

- Processor: 1 GHz or faster with two or more cores on a compatible 64-bit processor or system-on-chip (SoC)
- Memory RAM: 4 Go
- Storage: 64GB or larger storage device
- System firmware: UEFI, Secure Boot compatible
- TPM: Trusted Platform Module (TPM) version 2.0
- Graphics: Compatible with DirectX 12 or later with WDDM 2.0 driver
- Display: High-definition (720p) display with a diagonal greater than 9", 8 bits per color channel
- Internet connection and Microsoft accounts: ²Windows 11 Home Edition requires an internet connection and a Microsoft account to complete device setup on first use.
